Title: Cry Out

Main Bible Passage: 2 Chronicles 20

Big Idea: If our world is to experience God's rule, it will begin with his people in whom He has placed His name and His presence. If you are a believer, you carry His name, and you are His dwelling place. It is time that we Position ourselves to Cry Out to God!

Application: You are God's representative on earth to draw men unto himself. Is your attention on God, and does your life reflect the evidence of Repentance? Have the storms of life cause you to be stuck? Are you effectively sharing Jesus with others? Let's examine ourselves, Repent, ask Jesus for help where needed and allow him to use you to share Jesus with others.

Read: 2 Chronicles 20:9 (ESV)

9 'If disaster comes upon us, the sword, judgment,[a] or pestilence, or famine, we will stand before this house and before you—for your name is in this house—and cry out to you in our affliction, and you will hear and save.'

Discussion Questions:

1. Read 2 Chronicles 20:1-4. Discuss King Jehoshaphat and Judah's response to danger similar or different in comparison to the nation we live in today? As Believers, how should we respond to impending danger?
2. True Repentance will always consist of a turning to God as well as a change in behaviour. Share about a time you saw or experienced Repentance? What happened?
3. In Matthew 14:22-33, we know the storm the disciples faced allowed Jesus to show up, calm their fears, rescue them and grow their faith! How does this truth impact the way we should face storms of life?
4. As a Believer, you are called to be a witness of Jesus Christ. What does this mean to you? How has this message impact your witness for Jesus?
5. Spend some time praying as the Spirit leads your group.
