**Title:** Finish Line

### **Main Bible Passage: Jude 20-21**

**Big Idea:** Our life is filled with distractions and challenges, Jude gives us seven ways to spend our time (God’s currency to us) as individuals as well as a community of believers. We will continue from last week with the fourth way, we ought to spend our time, which is, ensuring we make our finish line clear.

**Application:** We need to organize our lives to ensure we spend understanding our finish line. This is important because our finish line will determine how we live our lives. We need to ensure that our finish line lines up with God’s finish line.

### **Read: Jude 20-21 (ESV)**

**20 But you, BELOVED, building yourselves up in your most holy Faith and praying in the Holy Spirit, 21 keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ that leads to eternal life.**

### **Discussion Questions:**

1. According to 1 John 4:7-8, “God is love and to know Him is to know love, a love that allows us to love one another.” Discuss in your group what you find to be profound as well as challenging in the statement above?
2. Take a few minutes and discuss what is important in your life right now, and why? What would you like the outcome of those crucial things to be?
3. We will face difficulties in reaching the finish line of our Faith. Talk about what Jesus instructs and promises us in the book of John 14:1-4 as well as Mark 10:28-31? What are your thoughts?
4. Did you have any Aha moments throughout this discussion concerning making your finish line clear?
